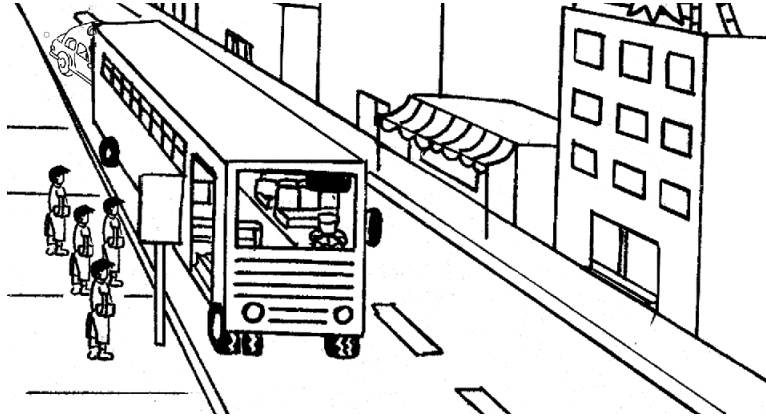


TAKING A BUS
